2020 Action Revisions: Summary

- 1.2.1: Participate in sustainable procurement training
- 1.2.3: Implement sustainable purchasing (% budget on sustainable goods/services)
- 1.6.3: Number of points correlated to number of C-PACE projects
- 4.7 (NEW): Planning for Long-Term Recovery
 - Identify a Long-Term Recovery Manager (possibly regional for smaller communities)
 - Appoint a Long-Term Recovery Committee to be led by the Long-Term Recovery Manager
 - Establish goals, bylaws and a work plan, including a Committee timeline
 - Complete a project on the work plan

2020 Action Revisions: Summary

- 5.3.1: Achieve silver or gold status in the CTrides Transportation Leaders Program
- 5.5.6:
 - 2019--Provide shared mobility services (e.g., bicycle-share or electric car share service). Fixed route services, dial-a-ride and paratransit were not eligible for points.
 - 2020--Other shared mobility services will be considered if financially, supported by the municipality.
- 6.4:
 - 2019--The renewable energy calculator must be completed each time certification is sought.
 - 2020--Clarifies must calculate a town's energy use and renewable contributions in the most recent year.

2020 Action Revisions: Summary

- 7.3.2 (NEW)—
 - Send at least 3 municipal representatives to the Sustainable CT Equity Training series
- 7.6: Implement SMART (Save Money and Reduce Trash), revised to align with stateprovided consultative support to municipalities (e.g., points no longer awarded for a community forum, etc.)
- 7.7: For recycling additional materials, clarification on which electronics are covered/go beyond legal compliance
- 7.8: Goes beyond food scraps recovery and now includes food waste prevention
- 10.2 (NEW)--Support Community Match Fund Project and Civic Engagement
